These have been focused on this year's theme for GA: Micah 6:8. Go over this theme and consider the meaning it has for you and your church.
- **Picture** 5,000 people traveling to a new place (our place), and pray that their journeys will be easy and safe. Some of the people coming to GA are coming from other countries, and this experience for them will be challenging.
- **Pray** that our Presbytery's effort to offer hospitality to these visitors is warm enough and helpful enough to make their stay pleasant and relatively carefree.
- **Pray** for the guidance of the commissioners to GA, that their decisions will be wise ones.
- **Pray** that the experience of commissioners and advisory delegates at GA will give them a new vision of the PC (USA) to take back to their congregations and presbyteries.
